THE AMENDED MASSACHUSETTS PAID FAMILY AND MEDICAL LEAVE ACT: WHAT EMPLOYERS NEED TO KNOW

As expected, the Legislature has voted to amend the Paid Family and Medical Leave Act to delay the implementation from July 1 to October 1. This change also affects other requirements of the Act, including when employers must provide notice to their employees and remit their contributions to the state.
