The settlement was reached on the eve of going to trial. Pisegna and Lundberg represented the guardian of the police officer who was critically injured while on duty when a motorist struck his police cruiser.

When the city refused to pay for uninsured medical expenses for the patrolman, Krokidas & Bluestein filed suit in Massachusetts Probate Court arguing that the patrolman was entitled to medical coverage at the levels requested. Following lengthy pretrial discovery proceedings and pre-trial motion practice in which the firm was able to obtain sanctions against the city, the case settled just before going to trial. The city agreed to reimburse the patrolman's guardian for more than \$1 million of medical expenses incurred to date, and to reimburse medical expenses going forward throughout the patrolman's life.
